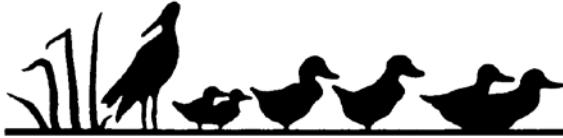

2019 GENERAL MEETING AND PROGRAM

Wednesday, November 20, 7:00 p.m.

“Wetlands Restoration at Lake Apopka, Florida”

Speaker: David Walker

David will be speaking about his work at the St. Johns River Water Management District as Basin Program Manager for the Upper Ocklawaha River and Lake Apopka Restoration Programs northwest of Orlando, Florida.

The presentation will review the agricultural history of Lake Apopka, restoration efforts and science, how the restoration was completed, and the successful re-establishment of birds and other wildlife.

These programs include restoration of over 45,000 acres of wetland habitat and 60,000 acres of lakes that form the headwaters of the Ocklawaha River. A section of this restored area is now the number one eBird hotspot in the state of Florida, with 353 recorded species.

There will also be an update on the latest news at Famosa Slough.
