

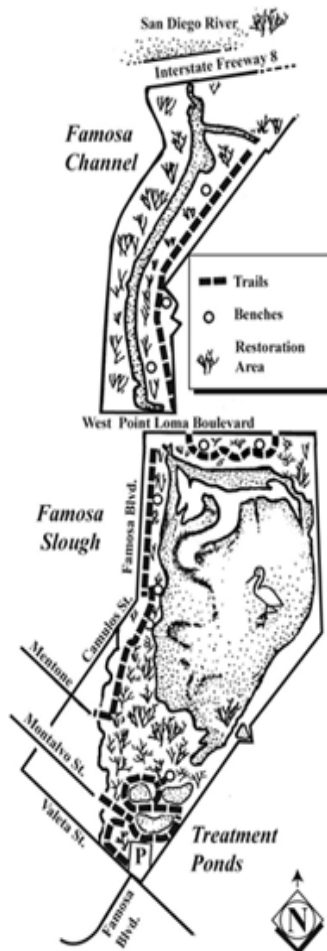
FAMOSA SLOUGH BIRD CHECKLIST

Famosa Slough is a 37-acre remnant of an extensive wetland area. The vast historic wetland area included areas that has since been developed into Mission Bay Park and urban residences.

Recent biological studies show that Famosa Slough still serves as a viable wetland refuge for aquatic animals and migrating and resident birds.

According to ebird, as of July 2021, over 243 bird species have been observed at Famosa Slough with several known to use the Slough for nesting. The 8th Edition of the Famosa Slough Bird List includes the commonly seen species at the Slough.

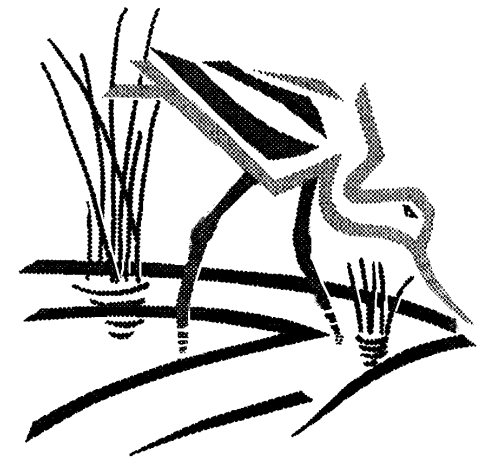
